Because of my love for trucking and desire to serve, in 2009 I started Haulin' for Humanity, a 501 (c)(3) non-profit that provided low cost trucking services to other non-profits and churches. After working with Feeding America, the Northern Illinois Food Bank and the Harry Chapin Food Bank, a new inspiration to provide books to underprivileged children changed my direction and Big Rig Books was born.

Big Rig Books has been evolving, and still is, since I first came up with the concept in the spring of 2012 at a benefit for By The Hand, an organization for which my daughter, Cara, works. The theme for that benefit was "Reading Will Take You Far". It stressed the importance of children having their own books at home. Starting Big Rig Books has obviously been very challenging and financially straining. It also involves an immense amount of work 7 seven days a week. However, the response of appreciation and encouragement we have received from principals, teachers, students and parents has made it all worthwhile, and I look forward to each and every day with joy and pleasure that Kathy and I can serve these precious children with grace and gratitude.


