

# This Week in History World Events

September 10, 2107 - Huuricane Irma made landfall on the continental U.S. at Marco Island Florida. The largest and most intense storm recorded to make landfall in the US. At one point Irma would have covered the state of Texas at one time.

September 25, 1690 - The first American newspaper was published. A single edition of Publick Occurrences Both Foreign and Domestick appeared in Boston, Massachusetts.

September 26, 1960 - The first-ever televised presidential debate occurred between presidential candidates John F. Kennedy and Richard M. Nixon.

September 30, 1949 - The Berlin Airlift concluded after 277,264 flights carrying over 2 million tons of supplies to the people of West Berlin, who were blockaded by the Soviets.

October 1, 1908 - Henry Ford's Model T, a "universal car" designed for the masses, went on sale for the first time.







